Fees: \$15 per class. Checks should be made payable to LTRF.

Awards: Champion and Reserve Champion; ribbons to sixth place for each class.

**Directions:** Morven Park's Equestrian Center is located one mile North of the town of Leesburg off Route 15 on Route 740 (Tutt Lane). Turn onto Route 740 (Tutt Lane), go 1/2 mile - entrance on left. **From the Washington Beltway (I-495) SEE WEBSITE FOR FURTHER DIRECTIONS.**

- Take the Dulles Toll road (Rt 267) west
- At exit 9, Rt 28 (Sully Rd) turn right and go north to Rt 7.
- Exit west to Leesburg on Rt 7
- Take the Leesburg By-Pass (Rt 15.)
- Go North on Rt 15 By-Pass to just beyond the turnback to Business 15.
- Turn left on Tutt Lane (Rt 740)
- Continue 1/2 mile to the Morven Park entrance on the left.

**Option from I-495**

- Take the Dulles Greenway from the Dulles Toll Road (direct)
- To Rt 15 By-Pass north at Leesburg.
- Go north on By-Pass and go North on Rt 15
- By-Pass to just beyond the turnback to Business 15.
- Turn left on Tutt Lane (Rt 740)
- Continue 1/2 mile to the Morven Park entrance on the left.

Other info: **NO DOGS ALLOWED.** Proper riding attire required, such as, riding pants, paddock boots, polo shirt or other nice shirt. **A copy of a current negative coggins must be included with the entry form.** Stalls available for \$20 - must provide own shavings. Refreshments will be available for purchase.

**Classes:**

Equitation Division: judged on the riders' position, ability to control their horse and horsemanship.

Class 1: minimal walk/ trot (leaders and side walkers)

Class 2: walk/trot (independent)

Class 3: walk, trot, canter

**Pleasure/ Hunter Hack Division; to be judged on the horse's way of going, horses should look like they are a pleasure to ride. In the hack class riders will be asked to walk or trot over pole piles.**

Class 4: pleasure minimal walk/trot (leaders and side walkers)

Class 5: pleasure walk /trot (independent)

Class 6: pleasure walk, trot, canter

Class 7: Hunter hack walk/ trot (independent)

**Dressage Division: Riders may enter more than one Dressage class. Dressage will be held in the indoor arena. Dressage times will be posted on our web site at [www.LTRF.org](http://www.LTRF.org) the Wednesday before the show. It is the riders' responsibility to check their dressage time.**

Class 8: USDF Intro Test A (one aid)

Class 9: USDF Intro Test A (independent)

Class 10: USDF Test B (independent)

Class 11: USDF Training Level Test 1

**Games Division: Riders in the games division will be awarded participation ribbons. In the trail class riders will be asked to do a course of obstacles including cones, cavaletti, around barrels, over the bridge. Obstacle course will be timed.**

Class 12: Extreme Trail Class/Obstacle Course

Class 13: Pony Express Relay – Riders help deliver the mail in relay teams.

Class 14: Fruit loop Relay – Riders will scoop "Loops" into measuring cups, then relay back to next rider on the team and the results will be measured!
